

Montana's Prison Population FY04- FY13

Attached is a chart showing the numbers of offenders entering and leaving prisons in Montana over the past decade. For the most recent year, FY 13, there were 1,173 admissions and 1,177 releases.

County Jails

Similar statewide statistics for county jails are not tracked. County jails serve as a temporary holding point for offenders who are awaiting transportation to prison or an alternate placement. Almost every person coming into a facility passes through a county jail. In addition, community corrections offenders who are awaiting a disciplinary hearing may be placed in a county jail and, after the hearing, may be returned to their community placement, be placed in a revocation center, or sent to prison.
