Amendment #2 (Sen. Moe) on “Recruitment and Retention” section

1. Page 18 and 19.

Strike: line 43 on page 18 through line 2 on page 19

Insert: Late in the interim, Sen. Moe gained tentative support for a measure addressing recruitment and retention problems in rural areas through tuition waivers for prospective teachers who student teach in rural schools, a tool for increasing recruitment in rural schools that has been used in Colorado. Ultimately, however, she concluded that a more comprehensive approach to recruitment and retention was required, and at that point it was too late in the process to advance a more comprehensive proposal to the full commission.

2. Page 19.

Strike: Finding #4 on line 16

Insert: 4. Salary is an important factor, but only one of many factors contributing to recruitment and retention difficulty.
