

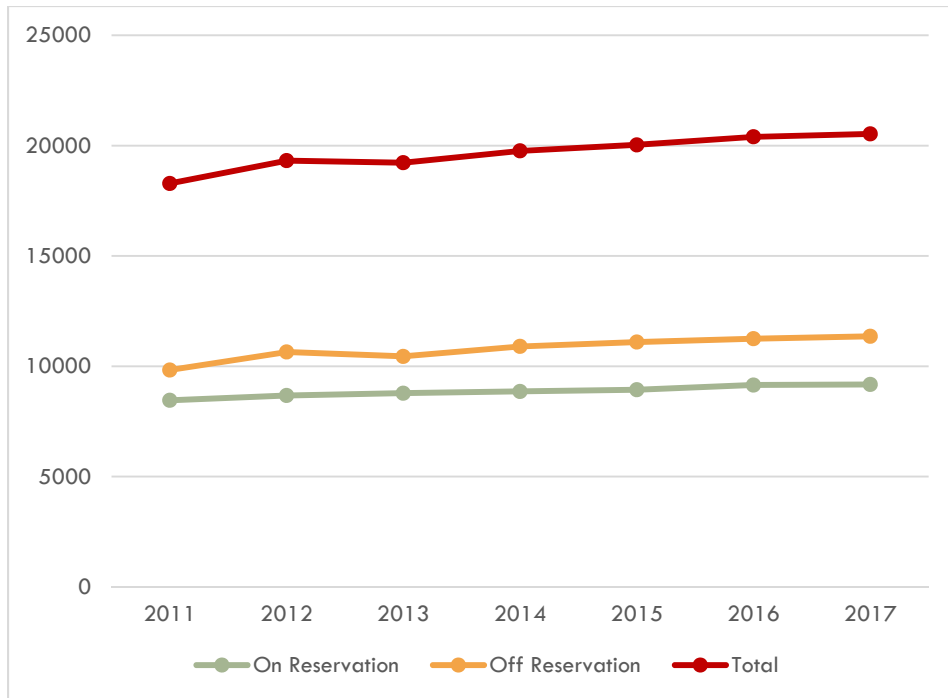

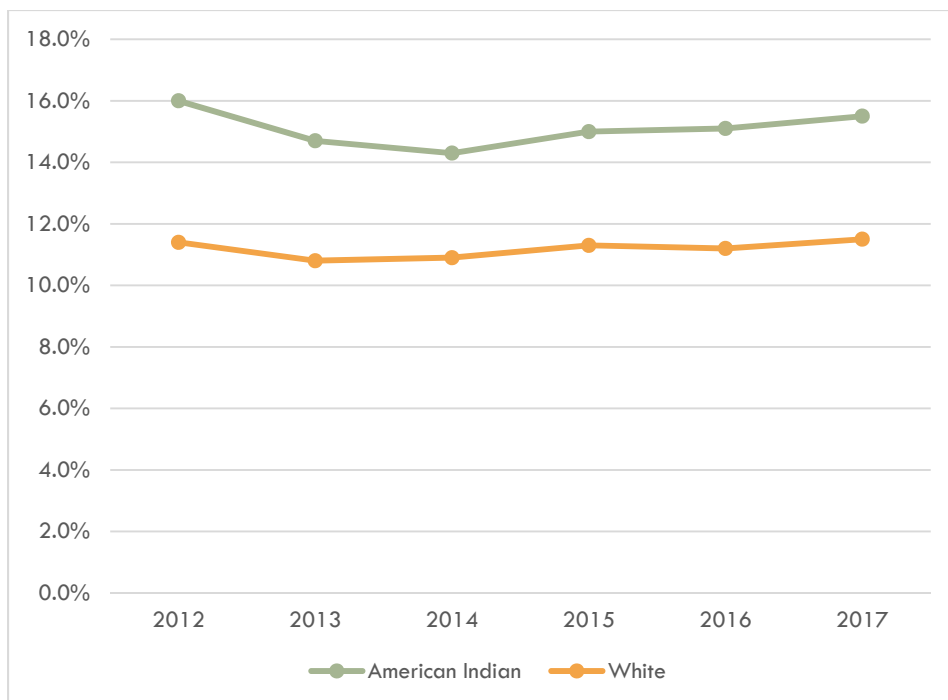

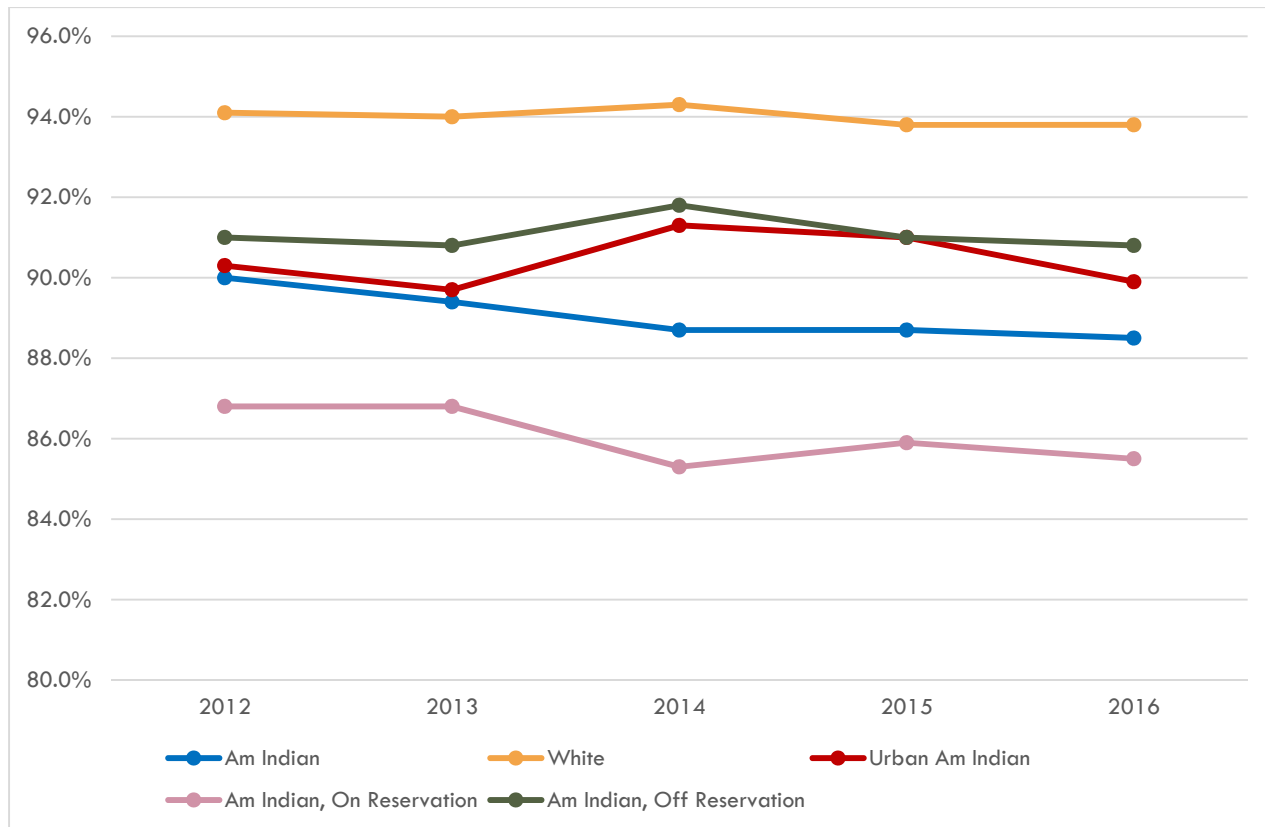
## American Indian Enrollment @ MT Public Schools

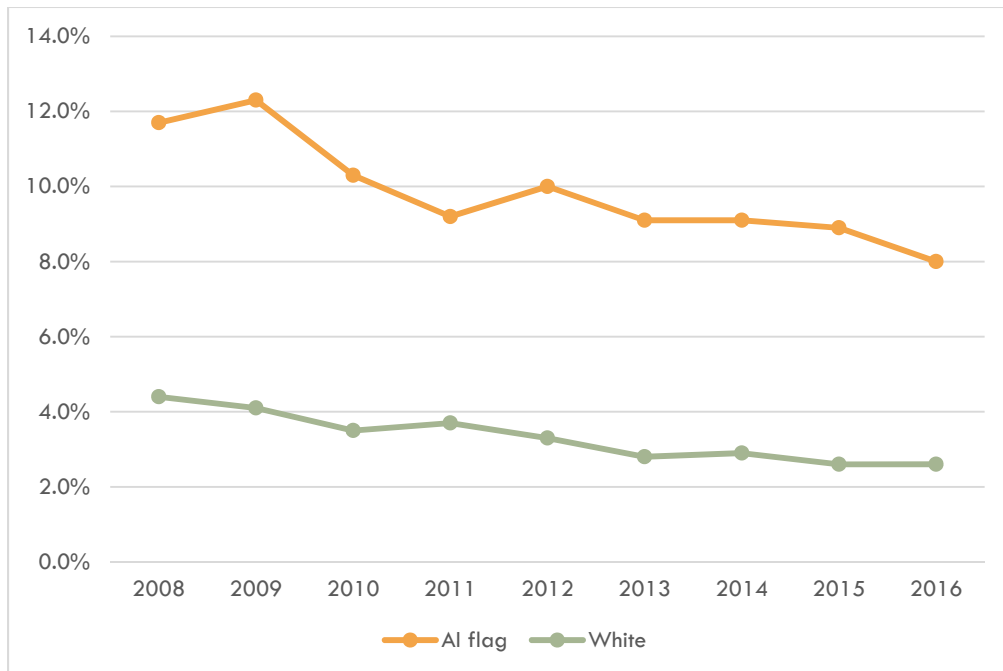
Note: Urban includes students in Kalispell, Butte, Bozeman, Havre, Billings, Missoula, Helena, and Great Falls.

The above chart shows the average attendance rate for each group. While the average for American Indian students at schools located on a reservation was 85.5% in 2016, there were 12 schools on reservations that had below average attendance. According to OPI, several schools had attendance rates of less than 80%, which means every student at those schools missed, on average, at least one day of school per week.

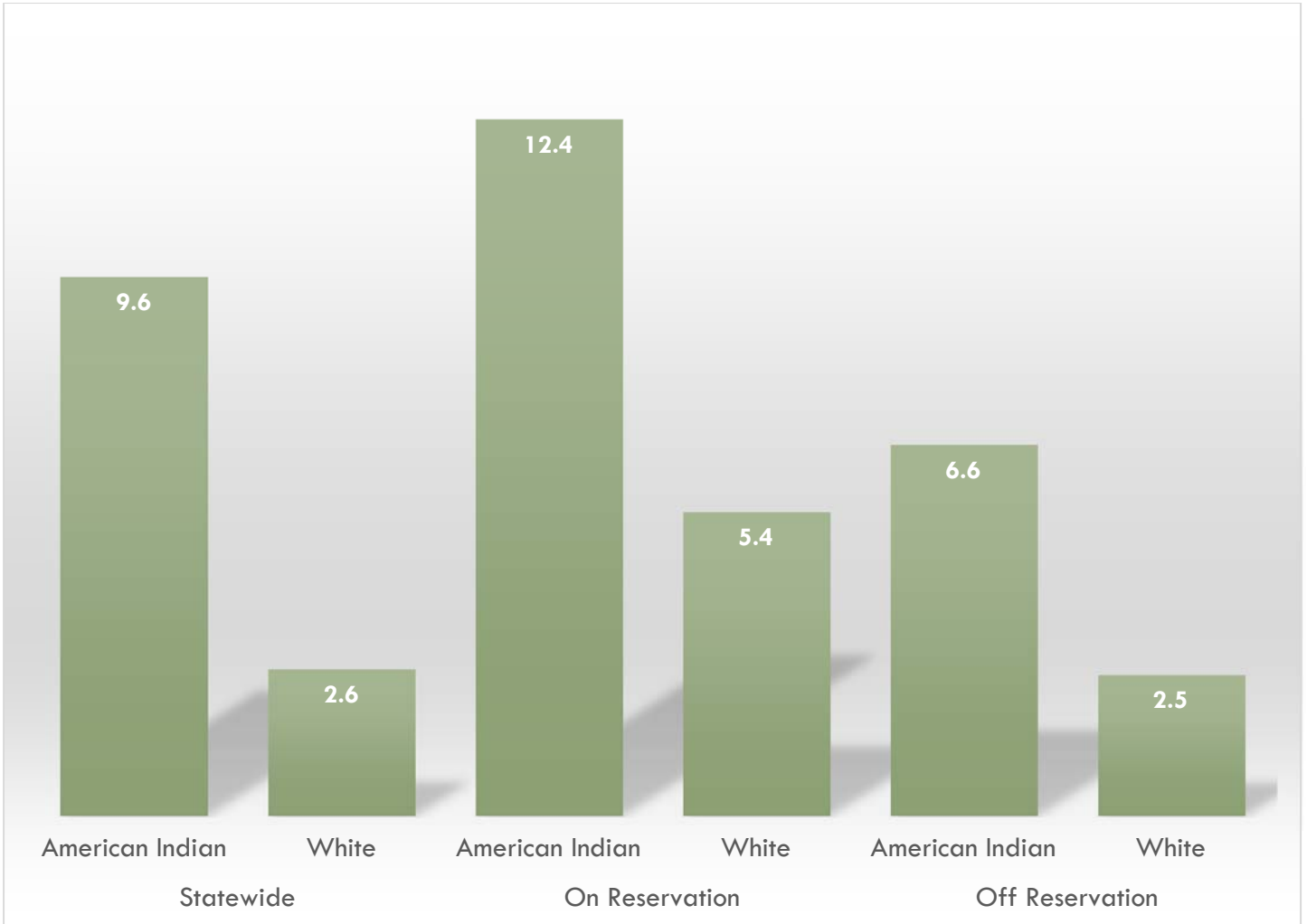

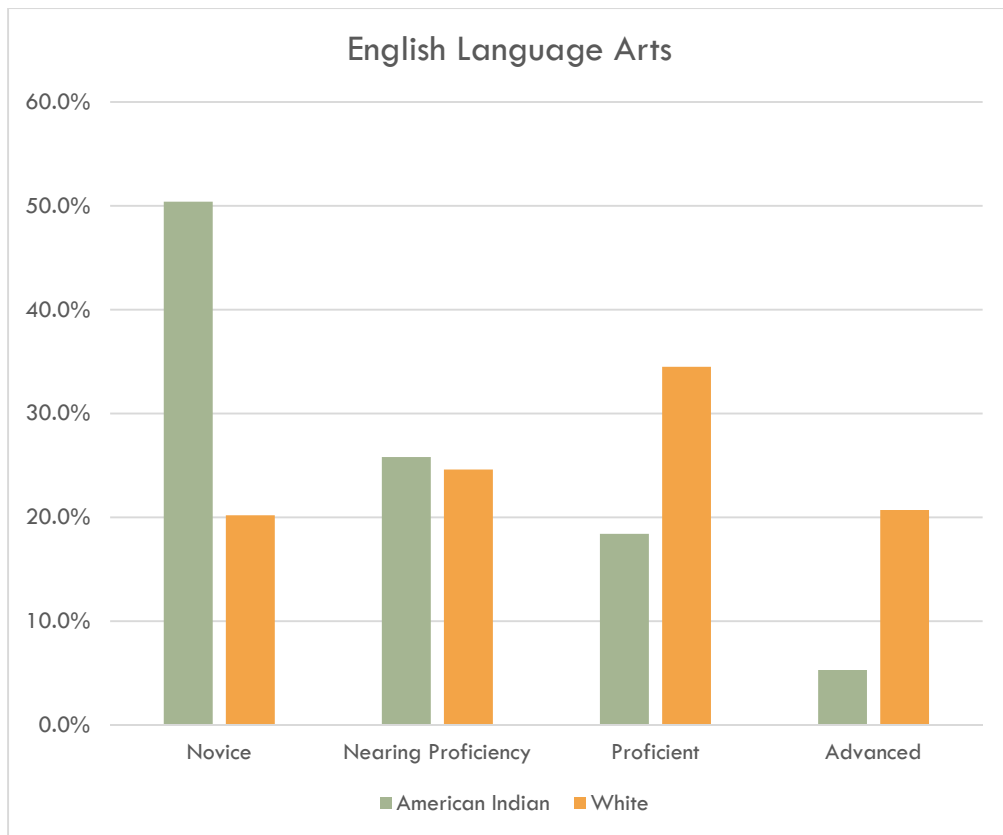
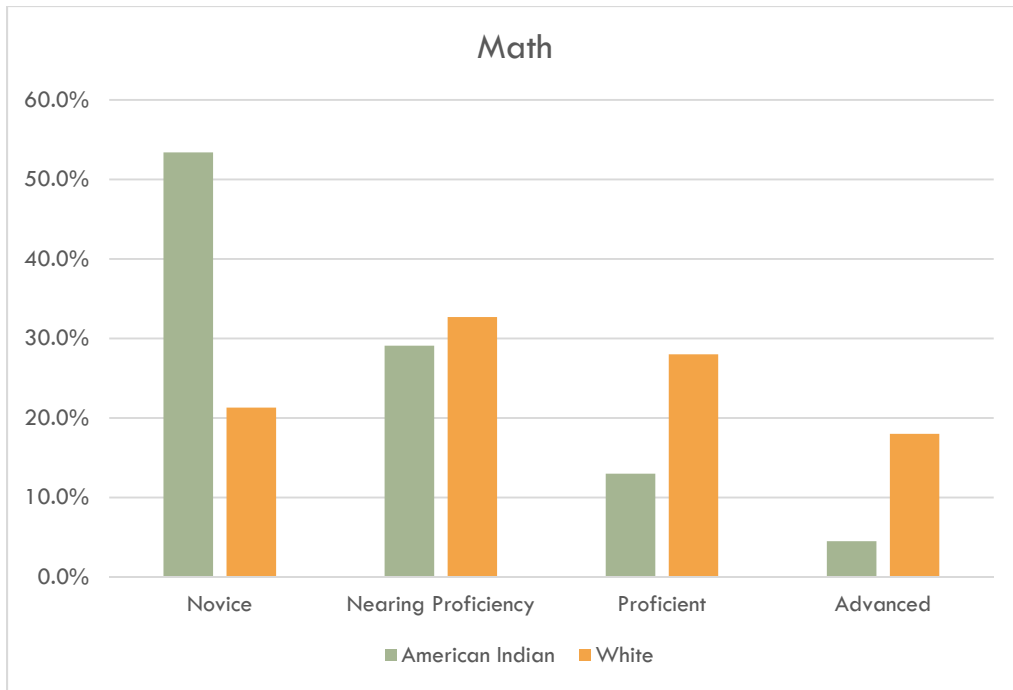

## Percent of Students Suspended by Group

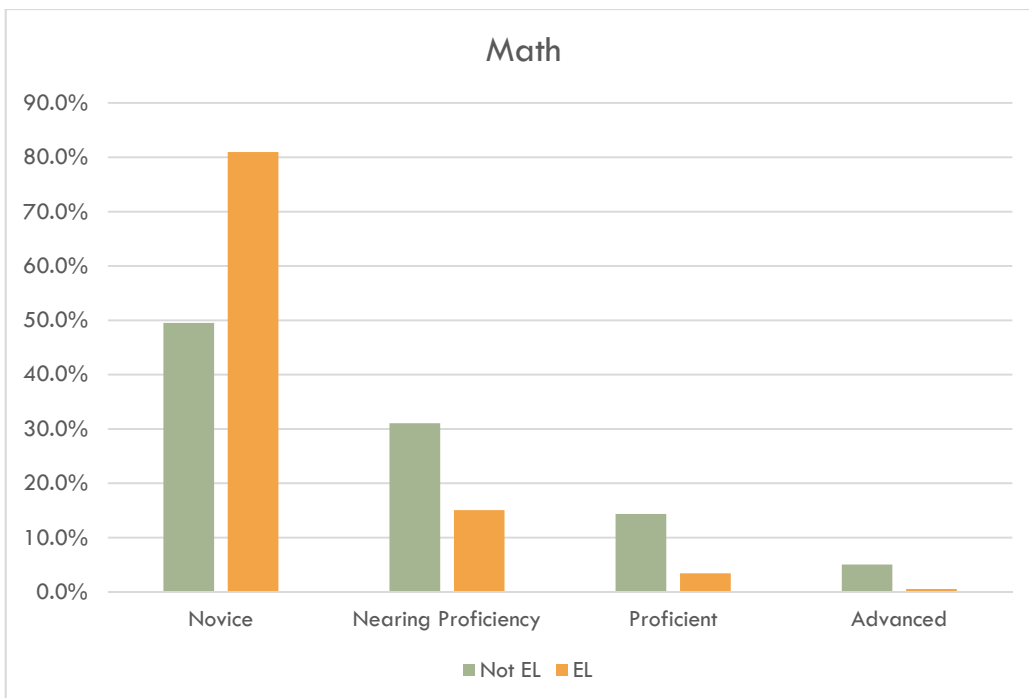
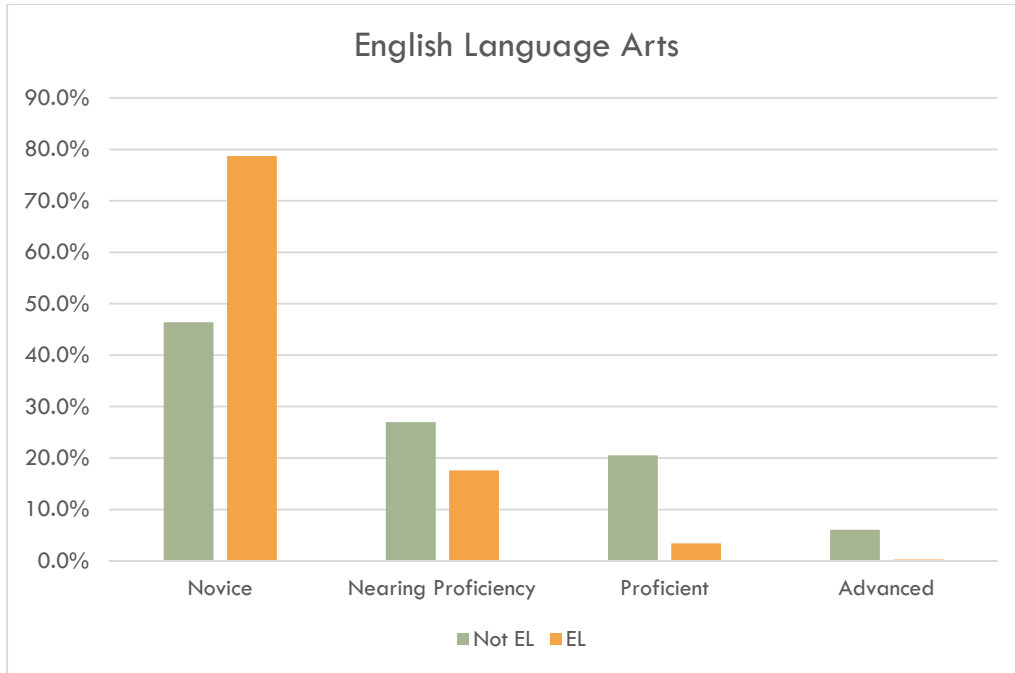

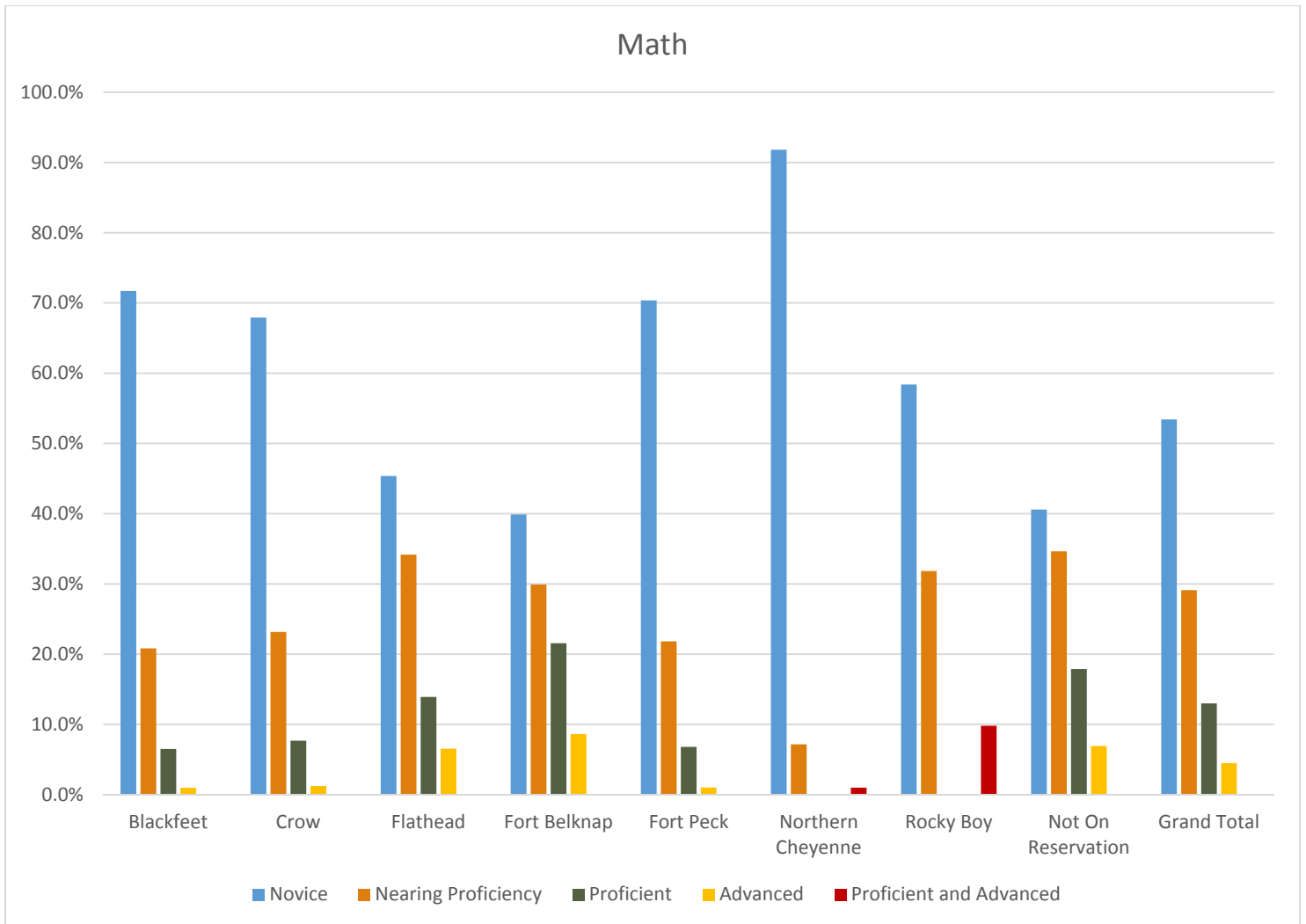


## American Indian Smarter Balanced Test Scores, 2016 By Type of Learner

EL = English Learners who are learning English because there is another “Language of Impact” in their lives.

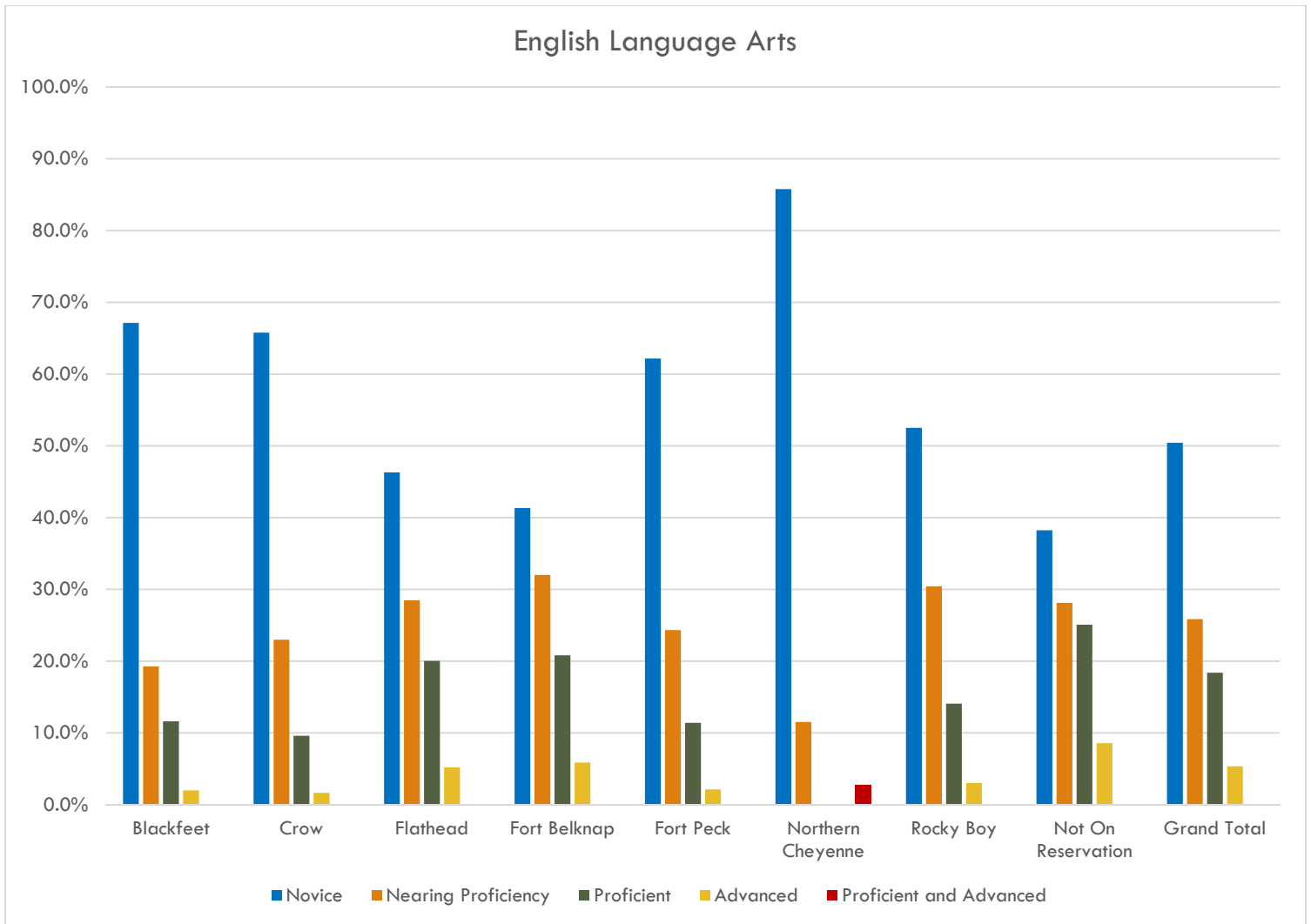


## American Indian Smarter Balanced Test Scores, 2016 By Geographic Area

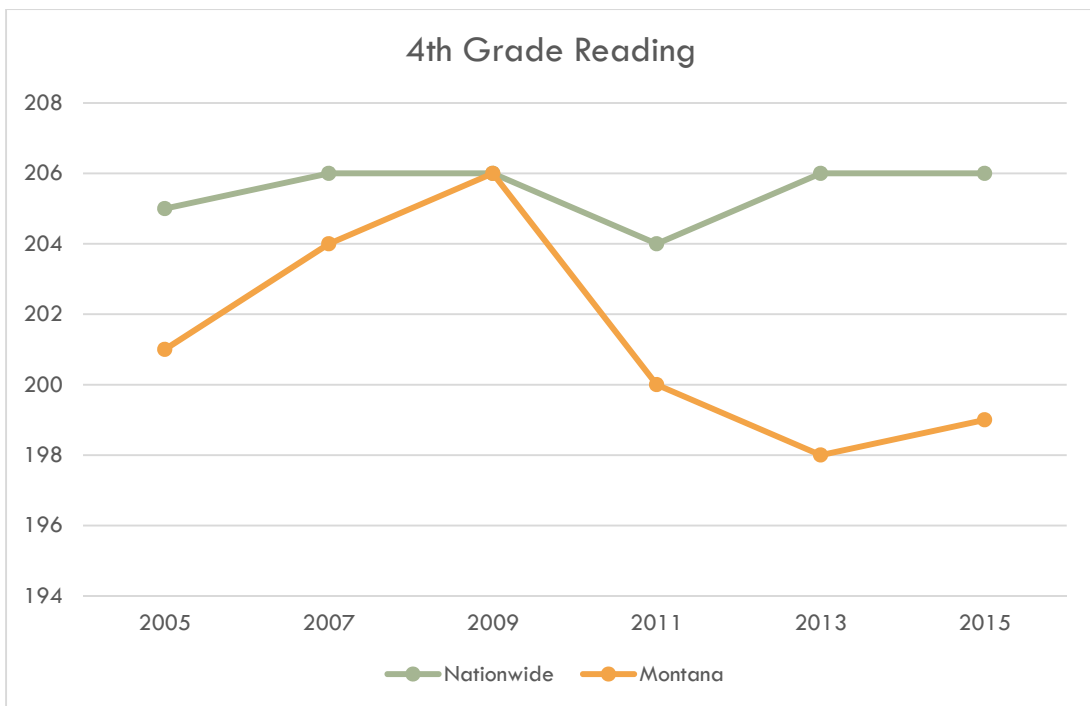
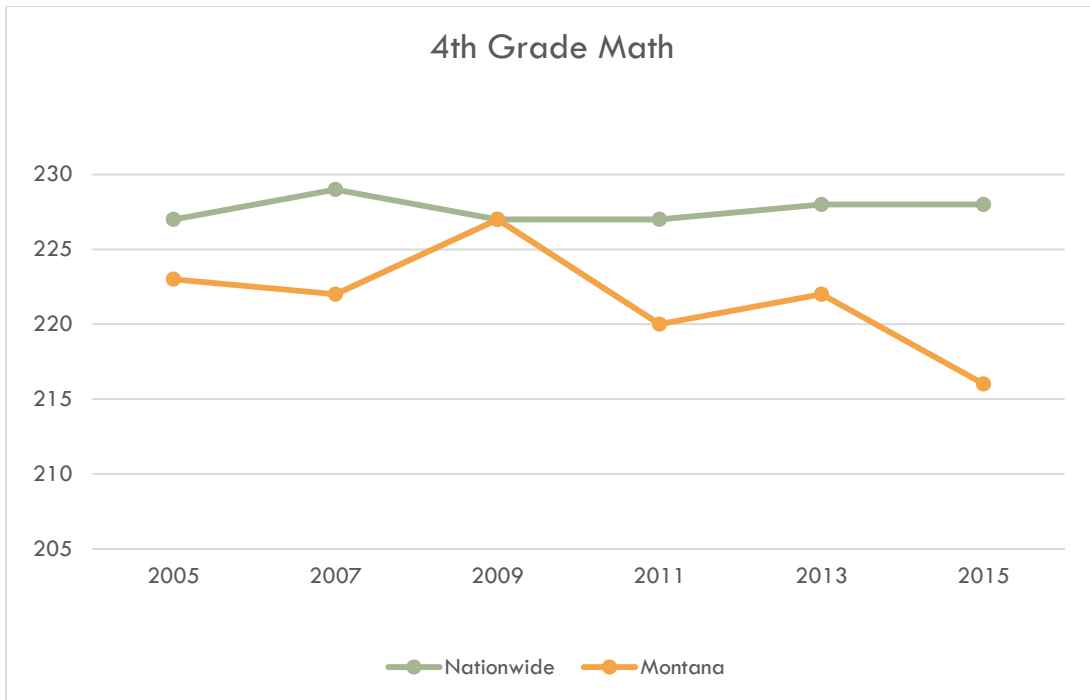




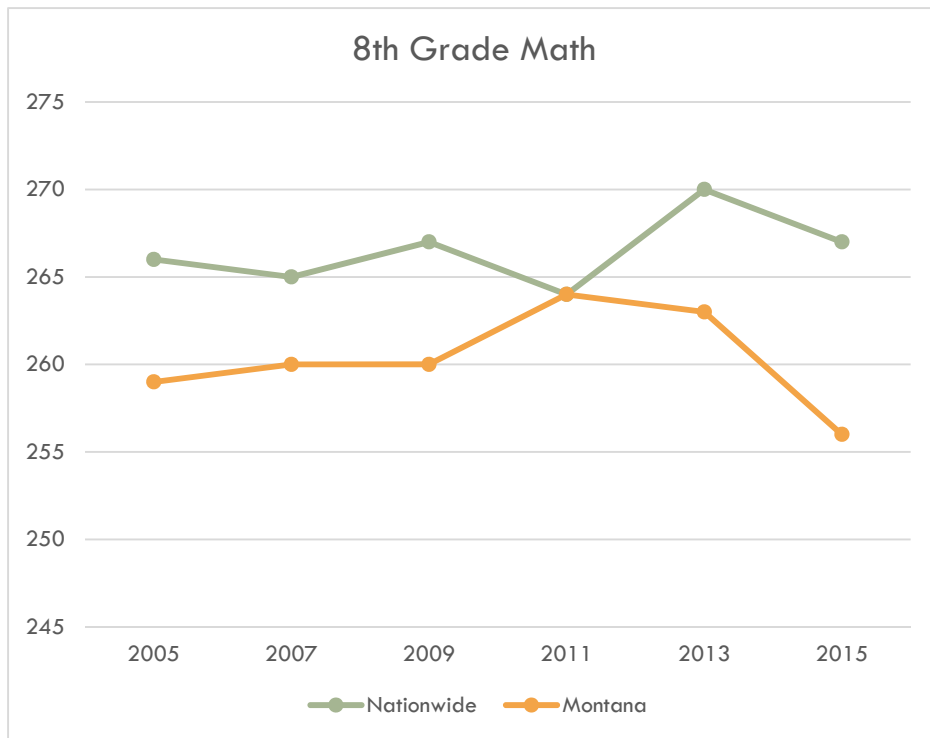
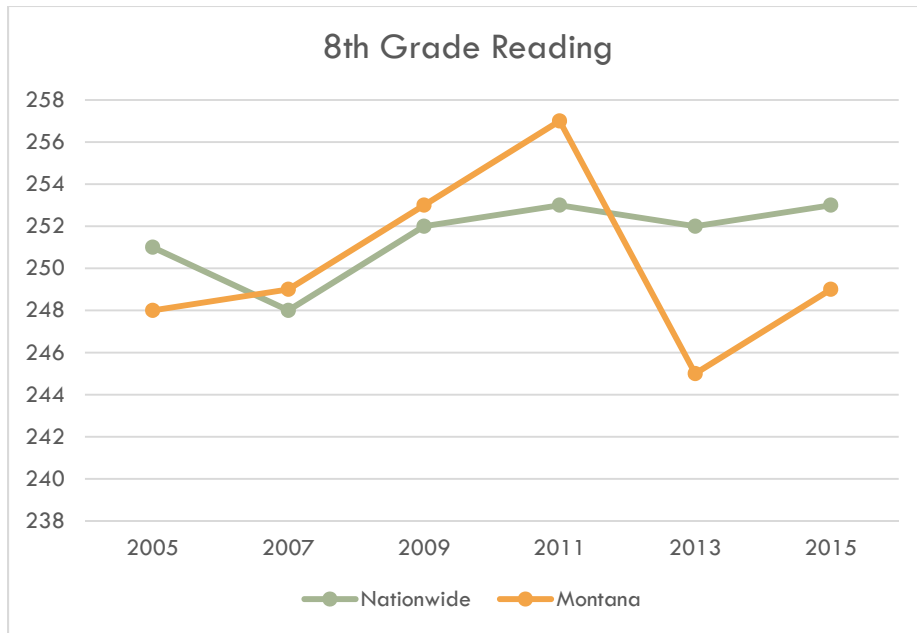
